

Rules of the (_____) Clan

1. The Clan Leader has absolute authority over you while you are under his protection, and over your family as well. Previous civil law does not apply as to personal liberty, with the exception that you are free, *one time*, to make the decision to remove yourself/your family from the clan property and not return.
2. As a subordinate member of the Clan, you will obey the Clan Leader(s) at all times, and you, in turn, will become the leader of your family unit, and they will obey YOU as well as the Clan.
3. You will be expected to provide sustenance (food/water/clothing/shelter) for yourself and your family. The Clan will assist your efforts of providing as it can.
4. As part of the Clan, you will be expected to advance the welfare of the Clan before your own, and if mortal combat with the Clan is called for, you will be willing to engage in that combat under orders of the Clan's military leaders. Your family is also under this General Order of Common Defense.
5. As you demonstrate responsible, subordinate membership in this Clan, you will be asked to provide leadership. When you are so asked, it would be to your and your family's advantage to accept the offer, as it will only be made once. As you use your appointed leadership and use it properly, you will be granted more authority and more autonomy from direct supervision, but you will ALWAYS be responsible to advance the welfare and protection of the Clan. Remember , as a leader, that you can delegate AUTHORITY to others, but you can never delegate RESPONSIBILITY.

These Rules are to be considered a blood oath. When you accept them, you immediately gain the strength of the entire Clan's blood, but if you violate them, you immediately incur the Clan's blood wrath. That wrath may include immediate expulsion, or it may be a mortal offense, with your life taken as a result.
