Chairman Priebus,

Sir:

I am a Conservative. My conservatism is simple, and stems from the US Constitution and it's interpretation along the lines of the thinking with which it was promulgated in 1787.

I will NOT represent the Republican Party in my Congressional District at this time, because it has strayed far from the Constitution, and embraced ideals that our Founders would never have agreed to.

Some examples:

The Founders would NEVER agree to a “path to citizenship” for any person who entered this Nation illegally. The Founders would have required that each and every one of such illegal visitors be hunted down, no matter the expense, and permanently ejected from our borders.

The Founders would NEVER agree to the restriction on the Second Amendment that was the fine print of the Manchin-Toomey gun Bill, and Act which would have led to de-Jure gun registration and probable confiscation of modern firearms.

The Founders would NEVER have agreed to Establishment of a religion by a State's Governor as Rick Perry is doing. The fight against abortion is a religious construct, pure and simple, and the Constitution forbids such religious Establishment.

The Founders would NEVER agree to seriously weaken the defense posture of the United States military as has been done by the President, but has gone largely unopposed by the Republican Party.

The Founders would NEVER have agreed to let an offshore trade organization, the WTO, rule our trade affairs to the extent that they can legally force us to adopt a particular tax (the “Carbon Tax”) without any consent by the House of Representatives, or fine our exporter by tariff if we don't.

The Founders would NEVER have just stood still and let a President of any other party bow to a foreign king, and then support a foreign religion which is totally inimical to our national existence and the existence of our closest ally in the Middle East.

Chairman Priebus, there is so much wrong with the Republican Party of today, I can only begin to list it's failures here, but suffice it to say that I do not consider that the GOP represents my view of what is right and good with this Nation.
